

Changes to my Will form

If you have already made a Will you can make a simple addition to include UNICEF NZ by completing the instructions below and taking or sending this form to your solicitor or Trust Company.

Note: We recommend that you seek the guidance of a solicitor or Trust Company when you make or upgrade your Will so that your intentions can be fully carried out.

You may wish to give UNICEF NZ a residuary gift, that is a share of what remains in your estate after the debts, legacies and administration expenses have been paid. Residuary gifts are very valuable to UNICEF NZ. They can, however, give rise to complex issues and it is particularly important to take advice before making a residuary bequest.
